Ana Popović was born in Belgrade, Serbia in 1976. Her father first introduced her to the blues, through an extensive record collection and sessions hosted at the family home. Ana founded her first serious band at age nineteen. Within a year, she was playing outside of Yugoslavia and opening shows for American blues icons like Junior Wells. By 1998, her band was doing 100 shows annually and appearing regularly on Yugoslavian television. Her debut CD, Hometown, provided a first glimpse of her talents as a singer and guitarist.
