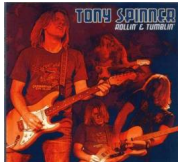

"Rollin' & Tumblin'", the superb sixth solo disc by this awesome, outstanding, world-class, blues/rock axeslinger from Arkansas, features 14 tracks (74 minutes) of awesome, top-shelf, soul-powered, "old-school" blues-based heavy guitar power trio grooves that will melt your blues away. Tony Spinner digs deep on "Rollin' & Tumblin'" and produces an amazing, timeless, authentic disc that definitely stands tall in the world of Classic blues/rock guitar magic.

Hailing from Jonesboro, Arkansas, this way-kool, down-home, blonde-haired Stratmaster Supreme is the REAL deal when it comes down to soulful, organic, earthy, retro-70s bluesy heavy guitar power trio grooves that cut hard and deep. Tony Spinner is an authentic, seasoned blues/rock guitar veteran who has played and toured with Toto, Pat Travers, Paul Gilbert (Mr. Big) & White River Monster, to name a few. Spinner knows what time of day it is on the Guitar and he absolutely "Shines" on the awesome "Rollin' & Tumblin" disc. An incredible, dynamic mix of blues meets rock from a True blues/rock axeslinger who's guitar playing skills are right up there with the best of them. "Rollin' & Tumblin'" also features the excellent rhythm section of Michel Mulder on Bass and Han Neijenhuis on Drums, both great players who lay down serious soul-powered grooves throughout this awesome disc. Tony Spinner & Co. do blues/rock loud & proud on "Rollin' & Tumblin".
