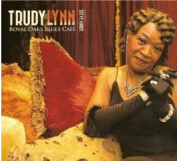

A composition which showcases Trudy's traditional styling's, a classic voice and flawless instrumentals featuring Steve Krase on harp, just makes you smile, bob your head and say "now that's the blues". Lynn was raised in Houston and continues to use the city as her home-base. She began her career in the late '60s as a Stax-styled R&B singer opening shows for Ike & Tina Turner and others passing through town. She began recording in late eighties for the Georgia-based British Ichiban label, cutting a fine mix of southern soul and Delta blues albums produced by Buzz Amato. Lynn currently appears on several blues festival bills, primarily abroad. --- Bil Carpenter, Rovi
