Chris Norman is best known as the vocalist in 70's soft rockers Smokie, of 'Living Next Door To Alice' fame. This is his first UK solo album in over five years and the lead single, 'Gypsy Queen' is released to mark his 45 years in the music business.

Good choice of single as it has a decent beat to it and sure to please the Radio 2 audience. The flamenco/Spanish flavour extends itself into the ballad 'Wish You Well', a song that highlights the strength and emotion Chris Norman puts into his music.

The rockier moments work well, from the opener 'I'm Gone' through to 'My Jenny', where Chris Norman's vocal takes on a rougher edge and reminded me of Nazareth and Rod Stewart.

'Whisky & Water' taps a Status Quo boogie riff and is great fun. Another change of tempo and musical style comes with the gospel flavoured 'Hard Road To Cross', a song that also features a female duet.
